If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.13 per \$100 assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>

<p>Shall the Board of Education of the Bismarck R-V School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,750,000) for the purpose of providing funds to renovate the original High School gymnasium, restrooms, and kitchen; to enhance safety and security measures; to replace the Preschool playground surface, the High School Family and Consumer Sciences (FACS) classroom cabinets, the front entrance digital sign, and heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units; to repair parking lots and the community walking track; to complete upgrades to the softball field; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?</p>
<p>If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.8400 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>

Shall the Board of Education of the De Soto #73 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Nineteen Million Dollars (\$19,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the betterment of school facilities to include, without limitation: heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) upgrades, repair or replacement of roofs, installation of security cameras and security film to windows, additional exterior lighting, and technology upgrades District-wide; bleacher and turf replacement at the J.C. Culwell stadium; implementation of ADA accessibility to Athena Elementary School hallways and DeSoto Junior High School gymnasium; to the extent funds are available, acquire buses and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9801 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
