**HEALTHDIRECT Institutional Pharmacy Services, Inc. (HDIPS)**

3 year term of contract (dated from November 1, 2023)

Pricing:

Brand Rx	WAC less 4% plus \$5.50
Generic Rx	NADAC plus \$5.50
OTC—Brand & Generic—	AAC + 20% (\$1.99 minimum)
Stock OTC—Brand & Generic—	AAC + \$3.00

WAC is the **Wholesale Acquisition Cost** from manufacturers.

NADAC is the **National Average Drug Acquisition Cost** of what pharmacies pay for drugs.

AAC is the **Actual Acquisition Cost** as Medicaid's determination of the costs of pharmacy's cost for the drugs.

We must provide malpractice insurance for \$1,000,000/incident and \$3,000,000 aggregate.

HDIPS will also carry this same coverage.

## No other up-front cost is mentioned in the contract.

## Termination of SPILLMAN contract

This is our official notice of default and intent to terminate our contract with you.

On April 9, 2024, your system experienced a catastrophic failure of the storage system, server, and backup with the resultant loss of 30 years of stored files and information. There has been little offer of assistance from you to help recover this data while we have spent tens of thousands of dollars attempting to recover the data to some form of usable state. To date, we have not been able to do so. All these files will now have to be entered manually to start a new set of data.

Consider the contract terminated at this time. There will be no further payments to you of any amount.
