

Sales tax report

- Sales taxes received 2025 YTD \$ 9,381,504.55
Sales taxes received 2024 YTD 9,308,480.39
- **Increase** in sales taxes received YTD \$ **73,024.16**

- For an **INCREASE** of **.78%**

Prop P (Use Tax) report

- Prop P taxes received in 2025 \$ 1,840,623.75 YTD
- Prop P taxes received in 2024 1,749,921.70 YTD
- **Increase** in Prop P taxes received **\$90,702.05** YTD

- For an **INCREASE** of **5.18%**

Currently **ALL** Prop P income goes to the Sheriff's dept for use of **salaries** and **equipment** purchases. This happens immediately and there is no interest income due to this rapid transfer.
