Approval of resolution -- Excessive force prohibition

A resolution establishing rules and regulations regarding the use of excessive force during non-violent civil rights demonstrations, including physically barring access to a facility or location which is the subject of such demonstration, and providing penalties for violations thereof. In the County of St. Francois, Missouri, as follows:

ARTICLE I

Section 1: The County hereby adopts and will enforce this policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individual engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations. The County also prohibits the physical barring of any entrance or exit to such a facility and will enforce all applicable State laws in this regard.

ARTICLE II

Section 1: Any person charged with a violation of any provision of this resolution will be served by the County with written notice stating the nature of the violation.

Section 2: Any person convicted of this violation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined an amount not to exceed one hundred (100) dollars for each violation. Each day on which such violation occurs shall be deemed to be a separate offense.

Section 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this resolution shall become liable to the County for any expense, loss, or damage occasioned the County by reason of such violation.

HEREBY AUTHORIZES the authorized representative, the Presiding Commissioner, to act on behalf of the County of St. Francois to sign the grant agreement if the grant funds are awarded.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The County of St. Francois, Missouri will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 15th at 6:00 p.m. at the St. Francois County Commissioner Office located on the third floor of the St. Francois County Annex Building located at 1 W. Liberty St. Farmington, MO. This public hearing is to discuss the county's submission of the application for fiscal year 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) program. The county is interested in obtaining all citizens' input on community development needs with the county. As part of the hearing process citizens will be asked to verbally assist in the completion of a Needs Assessment document. The document will detail what the residents feel are strengths and weaknesses of the community. The county needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State has established a maximum application request for each funding category. Activities that are eligible for funding include the improvement of public works, public facilities, housing rehabilitation, and others allow by law. At least 51% of the funds must be used to benefit low-and-moderate income persons. No displacement of persons will be proposed.

The county is proposing to renovate the former Mineral Area Regional Medical Center buildings. The area to be addressed is 1212 Weber Rd. Farmington, MO 63640. The total project cost is estimated at \$2,000,000.

All citizens are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed project.
