Auditor Louie Seiberlich asked Mr. Jones if there were any changes to the contract and there were not. Commissioner Kater made the motion to renew for three years at \$12,690 per year. Commissioner Buckley seconded. All were in favor and the motion passed.

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**


County Clerk, Kevin Engler gave a report and stated that today was the last day to report agencies to get on the April ballot. The Election department is working on putting together the ballots this week.


