**ROAD STRIPING**

Bids were previously opened for Road & Bridge striping. There were no bids received so Hwy Administrator, John Gross, attempted to get quotes from various vendors. The only vendor to respond was Tramar. Tramar has done the striping for the last couple of years. Commissioner Buckley made a motion to use Tramar at the cost of twenty-five (.25) cents per linear foot, \$1,320 per mile, and not to exceed forty (40) miles at approximately a cost of \$52,000 which is in their budget. Commissioner Kater seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

**APPROVAL GEOTHERMAL  
ENGINEERING WORK  
JDC ADDITION**

Commissioner Buckley made a motion to approve using Taylor Engineering for the geothermal work at JDC and Holcomb as a subcontractor. The total cost will be \$15,040. Commissioner Kater seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.




**ADJOURNMENT:**
