Dear Commissioner:

We would like to thank you for the opportunity to work with and for you, and we hope to continue this relationship. In the past we have made every effort to maintain the affordability of autopsy services, raising the cost only when absolutely necessary. The last increase for Pathologist's services was in January of 2019. The cost will be an increase from \$1850 to \$2000. We will only pass this additional cost on to the county beginning January 1, 2024, which should allow you time to make any changes necessary to your upcoming budget.
