

DETENTION AIDE I

The 24th Judicial Circuit is seeking an individual for the position of Detention Aide I for the St. Francois County Juvenile Detention Center. An employee in this position is responsible for the safety, personal conduct, care, and supervision of juveniles during a work shift. The employee is expected to exercise considerable judgment and discretion in the performance of duties in accordance with detention policies and procedures. An employee in this class works under the general supervision of a juvenile officer or detention supervisor.

Minimum qualifications and experience: High school education, GED or equivalent with one year of previous experience in direct care and interaction with children such as YMCA, day care, schools, recreational facilities, or residential care programs.

Must be at least 21 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Must be able to pass criminal and abuse/neglect background checks. Must be able to pass a drug test.
