Location data and message logs, including sender, recipient, date, and time, concerning the previous Snapchat messages sent to or from the Snapchat account “john.q.public123”

“MyMemories” data, “Stories” data, or any other data stored on Snap, Inc’s servers of Snapchat account “john.q.public123”, including sent and unsent Snaps, posted Stories, and any photos and videos that may exist.

Any saved Chats that may exist of the Snapchat account “john.q.public123”

All material and information requested shall only be from the date of January 1, 2020 to February 1, 2020.

That the basis of Affiant’s information and belief is contained in the attached affidavit of facts pertaining to said matter which affidavit is made a part hereof and is

submitted herewith as a basis upon which this Court may determine if sufficient facts have been stated to show probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that a search warrant be issued as provided by law for the material identified above.

AFFIDAVIT

Officer John Sample, an officer with the Sample Police Department, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is a duly commissioned law enforcement officer, and he has reasonable grounds to believe that the following materials described in the Complaint attached hereto is held and kept in the place described in the Complaint because:

1. I, John Sample, am a commissioned law enforcement officer with 10 years law enforcement experience.
2. On January 1, 2020, I began an investigation into allegations that John Q. Public had been exchanging sexually explicit messages with A.B., a minor child. The messages were being exchanged via text message and social media including Snapchat and Instagram.
3. An examination of A.B.’s phone revealed 5 photographs of a penis and were sent from telephone number 555-555-5555. After serving Verizon Wireless with a subpoena for subscriber information, 555-555-5555 was revealed to be the number associated with John Q. Public’s wireless phone account.
4. A review of A.B.’s Snapchat account revealed sexually explicit messages with another account identified as “john.q.public123”. The messages include requests for nude photos of A.B., photos of male genitalia sent to A.B., as well as solicitation of sexual acts.
5. An investigative subpoena served to Snap, Inc, revealed that the account “john.q.public123” is associated with John Q. Public.
6. In an interview with John Q. Public under Miranda, he admitted to having conversations of a sexual nature with A.B. but denied any images were exchanged or favors asked.
7. John Q. Public denied consent to search his social media accounts for evidence relating to this investigation.

8. It is my belief that evidence pertaining to Possession of Child Pornography, Enticement of a Child, and Furnishing Pornographic Material to a Minor will be found on John Q. Public's Snapchat account.

WHEREAS, the Judge of this Court from the sworn allegations of said complaint and from the supporting affidavit filed therewith has found that there is probable cause to believe the allegations of the complaint to be true and that there exists probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant herein:

NOW THEREFORE: these are to command you that search the said property above described within ten (10) days after the issuance of this warrant and take with you, if need be, the power of your county, and if said above property or any part thereof be found in said property by you, seize the same and take the same by you in the presence of the person from whose possession the same is taken, if possible, with a copy of this warrant, or if no person be found in possession of said property, leaving said warrant and said copy of the inventory thereof and with your return to this Court to be herein dealt with in accordance with the law.
